CONTEST RULES

The Queen and Princess candidates are encouraged to enter a project in the Youth Fair. Candidates must meet the eligibility requirements as listed in the general rules. Only one Queen and one Princess candidate will be allowed to represent a club or chapter. Previous Queen and Princess winners may not run again in the same age group.

Queen and Princess candidates will be introduced first at the Rodeo, Saturday night, March 24, 2012. The Rodeo starts at 7 pm and is Rain or Shine. All candidates will check in behind the Rodeo Arena at 6:30 pm to line up. Queen and Princess candidates DO NOT have to ride a horse during introductions. The Queen and Princess will be announced and receive their banners. Trophy buckles will be awarded at the end of the Rodeo when the rodeo contestants receive their awards in the Show Arena.

Queen contestants must be 14 & Up as of August 31, 2011.
Princess contestants must be 13 & Under as of August 31, 2011.

Contestants will be judged in 3 categories: Personality Interview, Presentation & Ticket Sales. NEW this year: Presentation (formerly Beauty) Contest. You will be judged on speech and poise during this part of judging.

Each category is judged on a 13-point scale. All three categories will be equally totaled to obtain winner. Consistency is key. You may win 2 categories but score low in one; therefore another contestant may win the crown. All this will be discussed at the Press Conference on February 27, 2012. At that meeting, all candidates will have a picture made for the Denton Record Chronicle and receive their packet and tickets to begin selling advance Rodeo tickets at the same time. NO ONE GETS TICKETS BEFORE THAT MEETING.
